



The Keystone Classic Miniature Horse Show

Classes Start at 8:00AM

Health Requirements: All Horses must have a negative test for Equine Infectious Anemia (EIA/Coggins). Either the Coggins AGID or ELISA test is acceptable. Exception: A foal (under six months of age) at the side of the dam, as long as the dam is negative. Animal identification noted in all accompanying documents must match the description of the official EIA chart.

Entry Requirements: In order to participate in this show, horses must be registered with the AMHR national registry. Copies of registration papers must accompany entry forms. Along with copies of 2009 youth and Amateur cards. Processing of entries will be held until requirements are met. Checks are to be made payable to Keystone Miniature Horse Club. Cruelty, abuse or inhumane treatment of any horse in the show ring, barn, and stalls or on the fairgrounds is strictly prohibited as issued by the rules of the AMHR and management.

Stalls Fees:

Includes one bale of straw per stall
Pre-entry \$25.00
Post-entry \$30.00

Mature stallions stalled alone.

NO SHAVINGS ALLOWED: Only STRAW bedding allowed.

Additional straw can be purchased for \$5.00 a bale with your entries.

Use of Stalls: Any one using stalls in any of the building at the Bloomsburg Fair Ground without paying for them will be fined double the stall fees! This includes tying your horse to any building. For you and your horses' safety, we have stalls available pre-order or day of the show.

Class Fees:

Open - Pre \$25.00

Open - Post \$30.00
PMC Classes \$15.00
Youth Classes - Pre \$15.00
Youth Classes - Post \$20.00

Refund Policy:

Pre-Entry class refunds or day of show classes scratched during the show will not be given refunds unless accompanied by a signed veterinarian statement stating that the horse is not fit to participate. Refunds will be mailed and not issued at the show.

Amateurs/ Youth:

Any ASPC/AMHR member participating in amateur / youth classes is required to have a 2009 amateur / youth card. Amateur & youth cards can be applied for at the show. Proof of membership required.

Measurement Requirements:

All horses are subject to measurement at the discretion of the ASPC/AMHR Steward and/or the Show management regardless of temporary or permanent status on any horse participating in the show. It is the responsibility of the owner / agent to have horses measured in a timely manner in order to have back

numbers issued before the start of the horse's first class. All horses must show proof of registration to the measuring steward at time of measurement. Measurement time will start at 6:00 PM until 8:00 PM Friday. Saturday measuring starts 7:00 AM and during show.

PA System: Please note that it is the responsibility of the exhibitor to get to his/her class. Show Management and the Keystone Classic Miniature Horse Show have made every effort to provide a reliable PA system. Refunds will not be given for missed classes. The PA system is a courtesy not a requirement.
